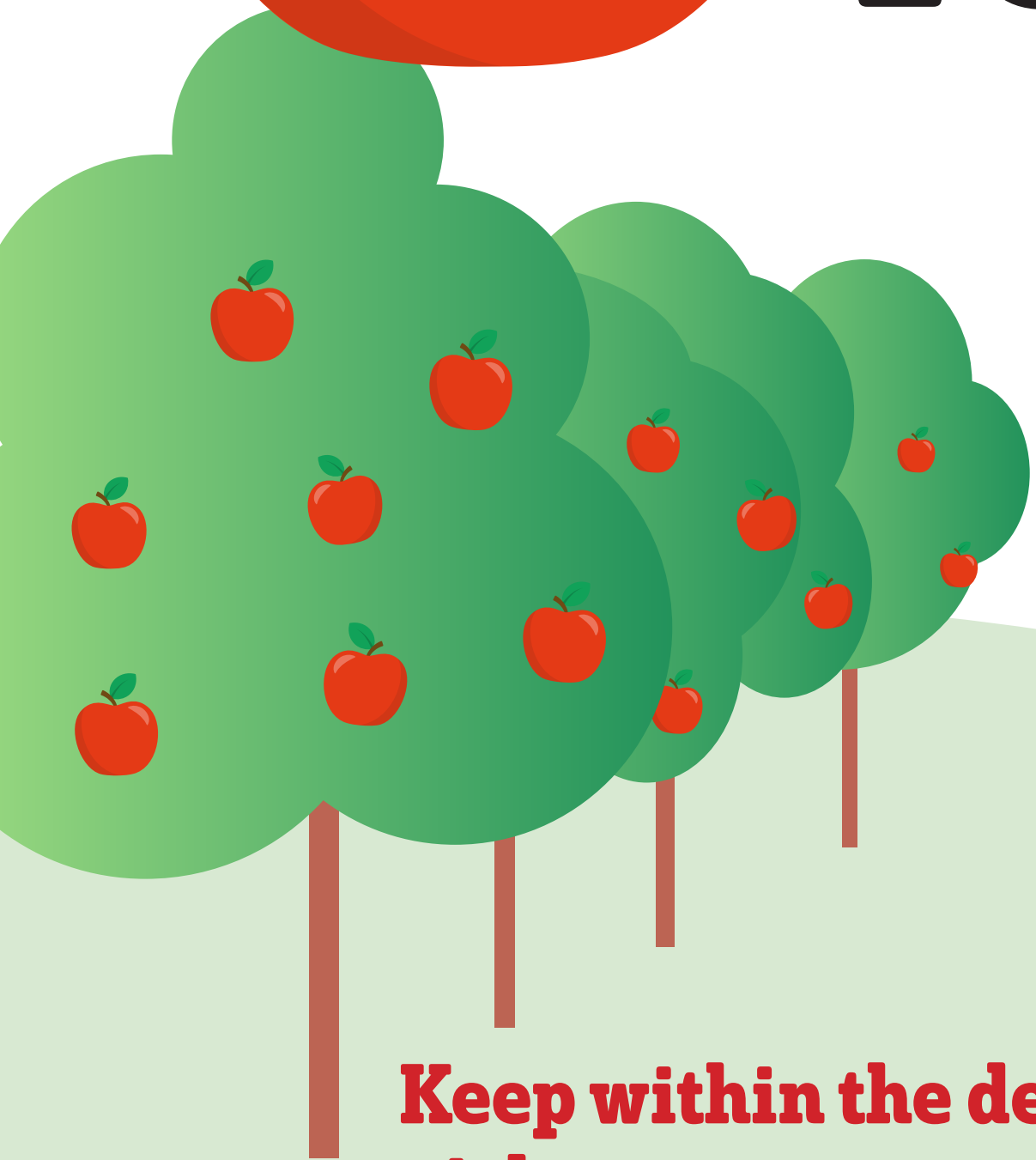


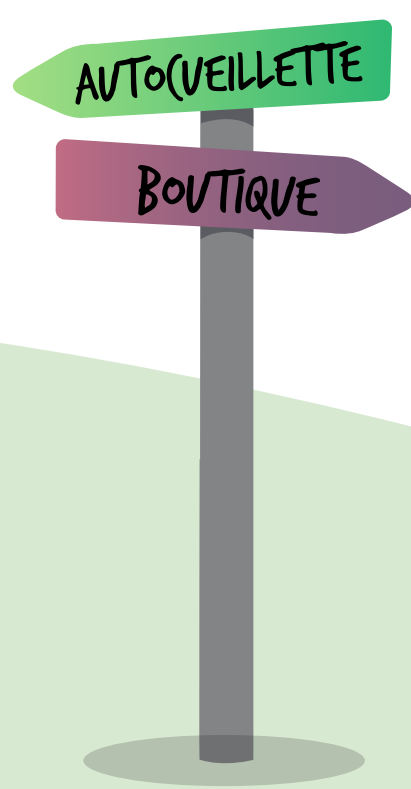


10 Rules for responsible apple picking



Keep within the designated pick-your-own area

in order to respect the harvest maturity of the different apple varieties.



Do not climb trees:

use the ladders provided in the orchard instead.



Supervise children at all times

for safety's sake and out of respect for your fellow guests.



To pick an apple, lift it upward while bending it towards the branch to remove it from the tree.

Do not rotate the apple or pull it downward; this can damage the tree and destroy next year's fruits.



Do not waste:

do not bite into every apple or throw fruit on the ground. That said, a small quality control check is allowed and even recommended for health reasons.



Do not break branches.



Refrain from smoking in apple picking areas.



Do not litter.



Do not throw apples.
